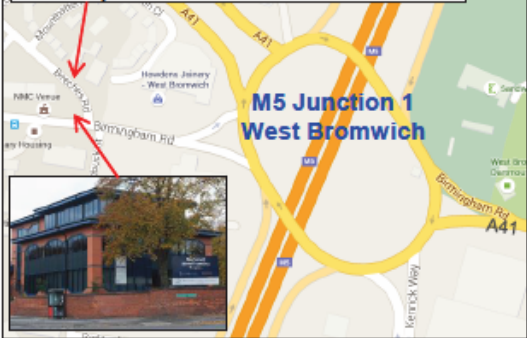

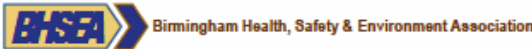

Asbestos awareness training sessions - 15 x 2.5 hours - are scheduled from end of January through February at various locations.

200 places are available in total with 130 taken so far.

The events are intended for SME's (up to 50 employees) who have employees likely to be exposed to asbestos in the course of their work.

The programme will be repeated around May time.

Note: In June, HSE will be targeting construction re-furbishment with particular emphasis upon educational premises, many of which contain asbestos.
