By Car (from the North or South): Leave M6 at Junction 9 and take A461 towards Walsall. Bear right on the A4148 (Wallows Lane) and turn right at the second set of traffic lights. You will see the ground on your left.

Car Parking: Free for over 1200 cars with 24 hour CCTV.

By Rail: Banks's Stadium own railway station only a few minutes walk from the ground. Trains run from Birmingham New Street with a journey time of around 20 minutes.
