CITB grants will support three forms of training

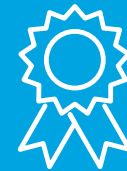

For an apprentice achieving a level 2 qualification you will have grant support of £8000

	Attendance	Achievement
Apprenticeships Level 4 and above (England and Wales) or SCQF Level 7 and above (Scotland)	£1,125 per year	£3,125

Grant support will be paid in quarterly instalments

Additional Info:

Employers with fewer than 50 people working for them are able to train 16-18 year old apprentices without making a contribution towards the costs of training and assessment. Instead, the government pays 100% of the training costs for these individuals, up to the funding band maximum.

Qualifications: CITB Grant Support



	Achievement
Short-period Qualifications (Vocational Qualifications at L2 and above and NEBOSH)	£600

(over 340 certificate, diploma or NVQ courses) including traditional craft skills, specialist and management courses

	Attendance	Achievement
Long-period Qualifications (HND, HNC and degree level)	£1,125 per year	£1,875

e.g. Construction Management HND; Construction Occupations BTEC Diploma ; and many others

Short duration training



- Supporting courses with a duration of 3 hours to 29 days
- Grant paid automatically when training delivered via CITB Approved Training Organisation
- Interim arrangements in place where:
 - Training provider is not yet registered as an ATO
 - A standard has not yet been established

Tier	Achievement	examples
1	£30	e.g. Asbestos awareness; Health and Safety Awareness (HSA) Demolition Labourer; BIM Management; Personal Fall Protection for Users
2	£70	Site Supervisor Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS); Asbestos Manager Introduction; Installing Excavation Support
3	£120	Health and Safety in Construction Site Management; Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS); MEWP Instructor

CITB Skills and Training Fund



Small employer delivery of training

- Available to CITB-registered employers with:
 - Up to 49 staff (£5,000)
 - Up to 74 staff (£7,500)
 - Up to 99 staff (£10,000)
- Aligned to Grant Rules (construction themed training)
- Additional support for Leadership & Management

e.g. Funding for small scaffolding company training 6 employees in COTS and CISRS qualifications. Total cost of courses = £4900.

Grant available £2600. additional skills & training funding £2300

Flexible Fund



1. You can apply for sums from £10,000 to £500,000.
2. We will fund up to 70% of the total cost of a project, and you will need to find match funding for the other 30%.
3. projects aimed at innovation or training and development.

Case studies

1. Lacey Roofing awarded: £15,030: The project will train five staff to CAA (pilots for drones) standard. The purpose of the project is to negate the need for staff to work at extreme height whilst carrying out roof work inspections working at height is high risk.
2. Project received £47k to run half-day training workshops designed to keep small builders up to date with changing regulations and technical advances, raise standards, reduce defects to disseminate information about new techniques. 360 individuals from 120 construction employers.

Structured Fund

Projects Commissioned by CITB to address a particular issue in the industry. 70% of the value of your project. You will need to find match funding for the remaining 30%.

Current examples:

Construction Skills Fund:

to establish on site training hubs. On-site training hubs are a physical facility which enables potential entrants to become site and employment ready.

Improving skills for offsite construction:

to achieve greater quality and consistency in the delivery of offsite construction training.
